**ATHLOS LEADERSHIP ACADEMY POLICY No. 6.5**  
**[CURRICULUM REVIEW & ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION]**

**I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Athlos Leadership Academy has procedures in place allowing parental review of instructional materials used in the curriculum.

**II. POLICY STATEMENT**

It is the policy of Athlos Leadership Academy to fully comply with state and federal laws regarding the right of a Parent to inspect any instructional materials used as part of the educational curriculum.

**III. DEFINITIONS**

The following definitions apply to this policy only.

- A. “Parent” means a parent, legal guardian, or adult student over the age of 18.
- B. “Student” means a minor child or an adult student currently enrolled in Athlos Leadership Academy.
- C. “Instructional Material” means content that is provided to a student, regardless of its format, including printed or representational materials, audio-visual materials, and materials in electronic or digital formats (such as materials accessible through the Internet) that are part of the school curriculum approved by Athlos Leadership Academy. The term does not include academic tests or academic assessments, nor does it include any spontaneous classroom discussion initiated by students or school personnel.
